Position of the institution	The Audit Office of the Community of Madrid was created by Act 11/1999 of 29 April on the basis of the mandate contained in the Statute of Autonomy of the Community of Madrid (Article 44). Its regulatory law sets the Audit Office as a body answerable to the regional Parliament in charge of auditing the economic and financial activity performed by the public sector of the Community of Madrid. In the exercise of its functions the Audit Office also acts independently and in accordance with the legal system.
Audit remit	The primary role of the Audit Office is the audit of the economic and financial activity of the public sector of the Community of Madrid, ensuring that it complies with the principles of legality, efficiency, economy and effectiveness. The sphere of operations of the Audit Office is the public sector of the Community of Madrid, which includes: The Administration of the Community of Madrid and its autonomous agencies, as well as its public institutions and enterprises irrespective of whether they are governed by public or private law. Local authorities within the territorial scope of the Community of Madrid and its autonomous agencies as well as its public institutions and enterprises irrespective of whether they are governed by public or private law. According to Article 15 of Act 11/1999 of 29 April, they shall report directly to the Audit Office. Public universities of the Community of Madrid, as well as any agencies, institutions and companies dependent on them. Official Chambers of Commerce and Industry.

	Also the Audit Office audits:
	 Contributions to consortia/trusts, public foundations or any other entity coming from the subjects which are part of the Madrid public sector. The provision and application of subsidies, loans, guarantees and other aid granted by the subjects of the Madrid public sector, as well as direct and personal tax exemptions and tax reductions.
