Position of the institution	The Court of Audit is a body of the Parliament. It is not bound by any instructions issued by bodies of the federate state administration and answerable directly to Parliament (article 1 of the Law of the Court of Audit of Burgenland).
Audit remit	Audit responsibilities are regulated in article 2 paragraph 1 of the Law of the Court of Audit and include, in particular:
	 Management of public funds by the Land, Institutions, foundations and funds of the Land, Companies in which the Land alone or together with municipalities holds more than 25 per cent of the shares or which are controlled by the Land, Use and efficiency of subsidies granted by the Land, Management of public funds by municipalities with less than 10,000 inhabitants and their companies, when the participation exceeds 50% of the shares or by any other type of acquired control and At the request of the Government or the Parliament of the Land: management of public funds by municipalities with at least 10,000 inhabitants, when the participation exceeds 50% of the shares or by any other type of acquired control
	 Special assignments are for example: If ordered by the Government of the Land: preparing expert opinions on the management of public funds by municipalities and municipal associations, as well as At the request of the Parliament of the Land: assessment of the financial consequences of planned Land legislation
