Position of the institution	The Court of Audit is a body of the Parliament. It is not bound by any instructions issued by bodies of the federate state administration and answerable directly to Parliament (article 1 of the Law of the Court of Audit of Burgenland).
Audit remit	<p>Audit responsibilities are regulated in article 2 paragraph 1 of the Law of the Court of Audit and include, in particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Management of public funds by the Land, • Institutions, foundations and funds of the Land, • Companies in which the Land alone or together with municipalities holds more than 25 per cent of the shares or which are controlled by the Land, • Use and efficiency of subsidies granted by the Land, • Management of public funds by municipalities with less than 10,000 inhabitants and their companies, when the participation exceeds 50% of the shares or by any other type of acquired control and • At the request of the Government or the Parliament of the Land: management of public funds by municipalities with at least 10,000 inhabitants, when the participation exceeds 50% of the shares or by any other type of acquired control <p>Special assignments are for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If ordered by the Government of the Land: preparing expert opinions on the management of public funds by municipalities and municipal associations, as well as • At the request of the Parliament of the Land: assessment of the financial consequences of planned Land legislation
