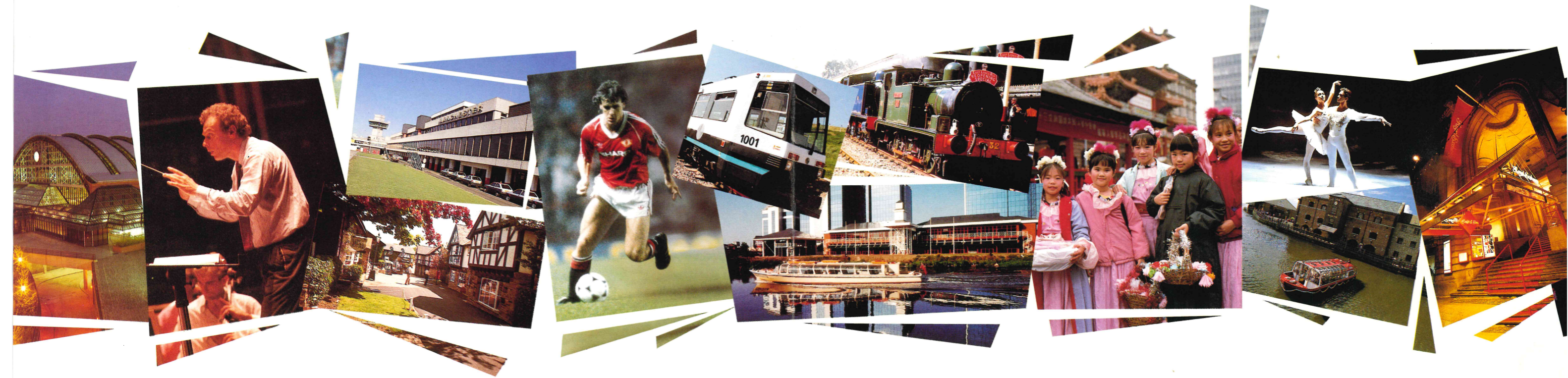

Manchester Town Hall, built in the late 19th century, is a fine example of Victorian Gothic architecture. It has 14 million bricks, 4,500 yards of marble flooring laid by Venetian craftsmen and 2.5 miles of corridors!
