Position of the institution	The Court of Audit is a body of the Parliament and as such it was established to perform the audit of the management of public funds of the Land, the municipalities and other legal entities. It is independent in the performance of its tasks and in particular, it is not bound by any instruction of the regional government or the head of government (article 1, paragraph 1 of the 2013 Law of the Court of Audit of Upper Austria).
Audit remit	The Court of Audit performs its audit tasks with complete independence and without instruction. It has along with the other tasks included in the Law of the Court of Audit the following duties (article 2 paragraph 1 of the 2013 Law of the Court of Audit):
	 The audit of the management of public funds by the Land, of its foundations, funds, institutions and other agencies, of companies with a share of at least 50 per cent held by the Land, of the use of subsidies granted by the Land, and municipalities with fewer than 10,000 inhabitants as well as of companies with a share of at least 50 per cent held by municipalities. In the context of special assignments the Court draws up expert opinions on municipalities, assesses the financial impact of the region's

	 supports the taking of evidence and the investigations of committees of inquiry contributes to the EU financial control and audits municipalities with more than 10,000 inhabitants upon specific request.
Internal organisation	The President/Director of the Court of Audit, the auditors and the other employees constitute as a whole the members of the Court of Audit (article 10 paragraph 1 of the 2013 Law of the Court of Audit).
