
# Financial situation of Upper Austria Status quo of the budget situation

- **balanced budget** has only been possible in recent years because of one-time revenues from asset sales and appropriating of financial reserves
- annual budget deficit mainly caused by spending dynamic in the health care and social sector as well as by high investments and subsidies
- > very limited financial room for manoeuvre from the operating business
- important areas (e.g. hospitals) were outsourced and therefore also debts were outsourced

# Financial situation of Upper Austria Development of operating business 2009

#### **Operating business:**


sharp fall of revenues concerning taxes (quota of the revenues of the federal taxes)

- strong increase of expenditures
  - result from operating business has halved
  - hardly any room for manoeuvre for investments and amortization of debts



# Financial situation of Upper Austria Room for manoeuvre for investments


#### Significant decrease of the financial room for manoeuvre


# Financial situation of Upper Austria Development of social spending


# Financial situation of Upper Austria Development of health care spending







# Financial situation of Upper Austria Development of financial reserves




- downward tendency of financial reserves was interrupted in 2008 due to sale of shareholdings
- hardly any room for manoeuvre to build up new reserves

- assumption of liabilities
- structural reforms

## **Measures of Upper Austria** Programmes to reflate the economy


#### Upper Austria's economic stimulus package – 1.4 billion Euro

- preponing investments in the budget and in companies owned by Upper Austria
- preponing investment subsidies
- special offers in housing, in particular concerning thermal improvements
- labour market initiatives
- implementing the gratis kindergarten
- economic subsidies, in particular assumption of liabilities



# Measures of Upper Austria Assumption of liabilities

- limit of 1 billion Euro for assuming company liabilities
- 450 million Euro used

- health care and hospital reform

#### Implementation:

- is carried out in projects
- groups of experts make proposals
- politics decide about the realization

# Task and administration oriented reform

#### **Objectives:**

- improvement in efficiency
- relief of expendable tasks
- considerable and lasting reduction of the administrative organization of Upper Austria
- sustainable cost reduction

#### Time schedule:

- 2010 2011 concept development, decision
- 2011 2015 implementation

#### Hospital reform

#### **Objectives:**

- ensuring the long-term financial feasibility of the hospital system by tapping the full potential for cost reductions
- securing extensive, adequate and high quality health care for the people

#### Time schedule:

- 2010 2011: concept development, decision
- **2011 2020: implementation**

## Structural reforms – the role of the Regional Court of Audit of Upper Austria

- Previous audit reports are considered in the reform projects.
- The Regional Court of Audit actively informs the expert groups about its audit statements and recommendations.
- The Regional Court of Audit takes an advisory part in the reform process, however it does not participate in the decision-making process.
- The Regional Court of Audit audits the implementation and effectiveness of the reform measures.

# Challenges for the Regional Court of Audit of Upper Austria

- focus on effect and sustainability
- cross-system perspective
- identify possibilities for structural change
- identify potential synergies
- process optimization
- increased communication and exchange of experiences with other audit organizations





#### 1. from the annual audit of the balance of accounts:

- develop a strategy to restore budget equilibrium
- structural reforms to reduce pressure on the budget (mainly system of subsidies, social and health care sector)
- anti-cyclical investment policies
- reduce spending and increase own revenues
- reduce the complexity of the transfer relations between administrative units, especially between federal states and municipalities





#### 2. from other audits:

- push the objective and effect orientation of administrative behaviour
- fundamentally reform the hospital system and social system
- reform the system of subsidies
- professionalize the management of shareholdings
