PREAMBLE

Court of Auditors Presentation

- Supreme external audit institution of the Canton of Geneva (independent and autonomous)
- The State supervision law governs the organisation and framework of missions

Scope of Court intervention:

- □ 300 State services
- 100 public organisations
- Several hundred subsidised organisations
- □ 45 municipalities
- □ > 40,000 employees
- > CHF 15 billion operating budget



PREAMBLE

Court of Auditors Presentation

- Skills divided into three "units":
 - Audit (8.5 FTE)
 - Evaluation (3.1 FTE)
 - Revision (4.3 FTE)
- Missions with varied origins:
 - Own initiative
 - Whistleblowers
 - Request from public authorities (areas of expertise)



COVID-19 HEALTH MEASURES

Overview of health measures (2nd wave)



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National level system

- Set of measures to safeguard jobs, guarantee salaries and support the self-employed (budget > CHF 70 billion)
- Panorama of financial support for businesses:
 - Allowances for loss of income for salaried employees and the self-employed
 - Allowances in the event of changed work schedules
 - COVID-19 loans (guarantee)
 - Specific measures for culture and sports
 - Measures for hardship cases



Cantonal level system

- The cantons implement federal support measures
- The cantons may decide to allocate additional financial support
 - For example: support for convenience stores and non-profits, supplemental support for hardship cases, etc.

Origin of the mission

- Internal considerations on the role of a control entity in times of crisis
- Willingness of employees to make themselves useful and provide support
- A real challenge for the department designated to distribute aid

Chronology of events:

- November and December 2020: deployment of numerous aids at the cantonal level
- □ January 2021: proposes support
- **February 2021: mission launch**



Scope of the intervention

- Focus on non-refundable financial support for hardship cases
- What is a hardship case?

Number of financial support requests received in 2021 in Geneva:



- More than 2,700 companies have received a financial support
- Total amount is near 400 MF



Breakdown of financial support paid by activity sectors :



Half of granted aid benefits two sectors (catering industry and hotel industry)

SUPPORT MISSION

Scope of the intervention

- Goals of the mission:
 - Ensure proper use of public revenue
 - U Verify application of federal and cantonal provisions
 - □ Strengthen the effectiveness of granting aid to businesses.

Roll-out in two phases:

- 1. Analysis of application processing procedure
- 2. Advice on implementing a control strategy *a posteriori*



Work completed

- Examination of the legal framework
- Analysis of e-form and its suitability to the legal framework
- Review of processing procedure by managers (progress test)
- Tests of details based upon different samples:
 - Classification of applicants
 - Identification of outlier data (data analysis)
 - In relation to the changing legal framework
- Monitoring the preparation of a specific control programme and updating the e-form (for the category "average sales > CHF 5 M")
- Advice on processing individual files

SUPPORT MISSION

Added value of work

- Improved controls in processing applications
- Limiting the risk of error and abuse
- Advice on complex and specific problems (area of expertise)
- Recommendations sent regularly and quickly implemented



General evaluation and preliminary findings

- Publication of an interim report on 22 October 2021:
 - Strong commitment and capacity to adapt by the department in charge of granting aid
 - Aid paid quickly, limiting the risk of error and abuse
 - Beneficial cooperation between the administration and the Court
- Preliminary findings in view of the final report:
 - Insufficient transversality within the State
 - Computer support could be improved



SUPPORT MISSION

Interim review of the mission: successes and difficulties

- Innovative nature of the mission
- Help to control risks
- Positive returns on the mission
- Boundary between control and advice
- Flexibility and reactivity to be maintained over several months
- Intervention in critical times within an overloaded department
